

<u>St. Peter School, Somerset</u> <u>First Grade Student Supply List</u> 2017 - 2018

Each teacher has composed a list of supplies that her class will need the first day of school this fall. Although these supplies will need to be replaced during the school year, your child will be ready to start the school off on the right foot. By giving you this list in the spring, you should be able to take advantage of the Back to School Specials that the local stores run in August. We HIGHLY encourage you to "stock up" on some extra pencils, glue sticks and crayons/markers when the Back to School Specials are available as often supplies need restocked half way through the year.

The following is the list of supplies that your child will need for school. Each teacher has specified the **exact materials** that she wants. For example, when a teacher asks for three single subject composition books, one three subject composition book will not be acceptable because it will not allow the teacher to collect the book to check your child's work in one subject without interfering with the other subjects. Therefore, only these items will be acceptable, so please check your items before you purchase them! Also, note that the students will be using soft pouches for their supplies. Sometimes it's nice to have two pouches. We ask that you only purchase the supplies listed below so that everything will fit in the pouch.

Supplies for First Grade:

- 1 or 2 **soft** pouches for supplies (no hard boxes please)
- 2 large pink pencil erasers
- 1 pair Fiskar blunt end 5" scissors
- 2 glue sticks (student size)
- 1 4 oz. Elmer's glue in plastic bottle or 1 8oz bottle
- 6 regular (#2) pencils with erasers (Please--no mechanical pencils!)
- 1 box of 16 or 24 color Crayola crayons
- 1 small personal pencil sharpener
- 1 plastic 12" ruler (wood or hard plastic NO BENDABLE RULERS PLEASE)
- 1 composition notebook
- 1 box Crayola Broad Tip Washable Markers Classic Colors

**Book covers will be provided by the school, so do not buy stretchable book covers for your child.

**Please send an old shirt, t-shirt, etc. to be used as a paint shirt during art classes. Putting your child's initials on the inside tag is helpful.

In addition, each child is asked to contribute: 1 box of facial tissues (100 box) for class use 1 container of anti-bacterial disinfectant wipes 1 container of handwipes Plastic forks (Boys) Plastic Spoons (Girls)

Please make sure that your child's scissors, crayon box, etc. are labeled with either his/her name or initials. This will help your child keep track of supplies.
